Requirements for Submission of Abstract:

- ◆ All abstracts must be on a single topic designed to highlight issues of interest.
- ◆ Presentations should be no more than 10 minutes in length.
- ◆ All abstracts will be peer reviewed by the Clinical Content Committee, which reserves the right to accept or reject abstracts for inclusion in the program.

Deadline for Abstract Submission: August 4, 2004

Submitting Your Abstract:

1. Write a 200-word description defining the precise content of the presentation. Outline the purpose of your study, methods used, summary of results, and major conclusions.
2. Describe your speaking experience and expertise with this topic.
3. Provide examples of how the material has been implemented.
4. Provide examples of how your ideas can be transferred to others.
5. Attach a short biographical sketch of the speaker(s).
